Job Description: Project Architect

The Project Architect is the key organizer responsible for successful timely project delivery. Under the supervision of the Chief Architect, the Project Architect will have 2 key roles: (1) project management, and (2) internal communication.

The ideal candidate should also be personable and able to demonstrate tact in communications and build relationships inside and outside the company.

A degree in architecture is required; licensed Architects preferred.

- Participate in design meetings with Architects, Landscape Architects, interior designers, and others.
- Coordinate between construction team and design consultants to ensure timely project delivery.

Internal Communication Responsibilities

- Document timelines and regulatory agency comments to inform future QA/QC procedures.
- Coordinate consultant payments with finance department.
- Forecast permit fees and coordinate fees with finance department.
- Track and report statuses of current permitting and forecast approval projections.
